Topic: Neighborhood Traffic Management

Commonly referred to as "Traffic Calming", neighborhood traffic management has become a hot topic for engineers, residents, and politicians alike. Traffic calming is the application of geometric changes on existing and proposed roadways to control both speed and cut-through traffic. This presentation will touch on the issues and application of these "Calming" devices. Common devices include round-a-bouts, chicanes, partial diverters, speed humps, and road closures.
