According to our by-laws, additional nominees for any office can be place on the ballot by signed petition of 12 or more members eligible to vote received by the Secretary not later than August 15. Any candidate unopposed by a nominee submitted by a valid petition shall be declared to be duly elected.

If more than one candidate has been duly nominated and has agreed to run for an office, the Secretary shall send to the membership not later than August 30, a ballot listing the names of all qualified nominees for contested offices who have agreed to run and to fulfill the requirements of the office if elected. The ballots shall be returned to the Secretary not later than September 15 and tabulated by a committee of impartial tellers appointed by the President.

Anyone who wishes to be nominated for a position, or anyone who wishes to nominate another, should acquire the support of 12 or more members of the Metropolitan Indianapolis Branch and send the petition for nomination to <u>ASCE.MIB.Secretary@gmail.com</u> by August 15. Built in 1903, it's the oldest Luten Bridge left in Indianapolis with considerable historical and architectural significance. But it has been neglected for years and allowed to deteriorate. It is also holding up progress on the 5.3 mile Pogues Run Trail because it falls along the proposed route and must be repaired before the trail can continue.
