Asset Inventory and DA Delineation

This presentation will focus on two key components of an MS4 Program: establishing and managing the asset inventory of outfalls and other MS4-related datasets, and processes for using GIS to delineate drainage basins. The Asset Inventory section will review the datasets typically involved in an MS4 program and discuss tools and approaches for structuring the inventory, populating that structure with information, and verifying and tracking its maintenance through MS4-related activities. The second portion of the presentation will focus on one use for the asset inventory: drainage basin delineation. The importance of delineating basins and how the process supports MS4 activities, along with a review of potential methods for performing the delineation will be discussed through the examination of a case study project completed for the City of Virginia Beach, VA.
