The Nashville Branch membership believes in providing assistance to our future leaders who are currently Civil Engineering students at our four local universities. The Nashville Branch has awarded over \$150,000 in scholarships over the past 25 years. Applicants are junior, senior and graduate Civil Engineering students. Scholarships will be awarded to those applicants who demonstrate the quality and standards that meet the goals of the Nashville Branch.

We encourage students at Lipscomb University, Tennessee State University, Tennessee Tech University and Vanderbilt University to take advantage of this program. Students working toward a graduate degree in Civil Engineering are also eligible. Active participation in ASCE is a plus, but it is not required.

The scholarship program is also available to the children of current members of the Nashville Branch who are enrolled in Civil Engineering, regardless of the school they attend.

Scholarship recipients are chosen in March of each year, and awardees are invited to be recognized at the April evening Nashville Branch meeting.

The 2020 ASCE Nashville Branch Scholarship is structured to be awarded to multiple recipients. Eligibility is open to any active student in one of our regions' four Civil Engineering programs: Lipscomb University, Tennessee Tech University, Tennessee State University, and Vanderbilt University. It is also open to current Nashville Branch members' children who are enrolled in Civil Engineering—regardless of the school attended. Priority is given to students who are active in ASCE. The Nashville Branch intends to continue this annual program to assist Civil Engineering students in their studies.

Who may apply? Engineering students who:

- Will be juniors, seniors or graduate students majoring in Civil, Environmental or Structural Engineering
- Can show financial need
- Have a grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale
- Are presently enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours)
