The NJ Turnpike Interchange 6 to 9 Widening Program consists of approximately 35 miles of road widening and associated interchange improvements from the vicinity of Interchange 6 just south of Interchange 9.

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) documents the possible impacts that a major project like the Interchange 6 to 9 Widening Program will have on various aspects of both the natural and humanmade environments. It examines all aspects of the environment including, wetlands, noise, air pollution and impacts to both public land and private property.
