FHWA TRAFFIC MITIGATION GUIDELINES

The number and complexity of road, street, and highway construction projects increase every year, as traffic volumes also continue to increase. The safety of both the traveling public and the workers exposed to these conditions continue to be a concern to the engineering and construction communities. Engineers and others involved in the design of work zone traffic control plans and those responsible for implementing these plans should be very knowledgeable in this important subject.

This presentation will discuss critical elements and emerging trends of the design of work zone traffic control plans and the safe operation of traffic work zones. It will also review and discuss the Federal Highway Administrations (FHWA) Work Zone Safety and Mobility Final Rule.
