2018 ASCE PALM BEACH BRANCH SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. This scholarship is open to high school seniors, undergraduate freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors and graduate students who meet the following criteria:
 - Currently registered, or will be in the fall, a full-time student majoring in Civil Engineering or related engineering field at a Florida college or university.
 - Is an active member of his/her local ASCE student chapter (college only)
 - A 3.1 or higher overall GPA
- 2. The ASCE Palm Beach Branch will award a \$1,000 scholarship to a high school student, undergraduate or graduate civil engineering students.
- 3. Applicant must have attended a high school in or currently enrolled in an ABET accredited college or university in Palm Beach County, Florida, and a United States Citizen.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee will evaluate the applications and select the finalists within two (2) weeks of the submittal deadline of Friday, March 16, 2018.
- 5. Applicants will be selected using the following criteria:
 - GPA
 - Involvement with ASCE Student Chapter (To be verified by ASCE Student-Chapter Reference)
 - Extracurricular and community involvement activities
- 6. The scholarships shall be awarded at the Engineers in Government Night (EIGN) on March 29, 2018 and shall be paid directly to the school of the student's choice for payment of tuition and/or fees, or to the individual upon approval of the Scholarship Committee. The recipient must provide the Branch with their student identification number for payment to the University and a picture for inclusion on the Branch's Website and Newsletter.
- 7. Prior recipients are eligible to apply again, providing they meet the above criteria.
- 8. The ASCE Palm Beach Branch reserves the right not to make an award if, in the judgment of the Branch Scholarship Committee, sufficiently qualified applications have not been received.
