

FORT WORTH BRANCH ASCE CIVIL ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The Fort Worth Branch ASCE Civil Engineering Scholarship was created in 2017 to facilitate and assist students seeking to further their Civil Engineering education.

I. The Fort Worth Branch ASCE Civil Engineering Scholarship may be presented annually to undergraduate and graduate Civil Engineering students, who will use the scholarship for their sophomore, junior, senior or post-graduate tuition expenses and fees. Preference will be given to students that are Sophomore and Junior level.

II. The purpose of the scholarship is to assist with and facilitate the education of worthy students that are motivated by and interested in pursuing a degree and future career in Civil Engineering.

III. Eligibility

- a. The applicant must be a student majoring in Civil Engineering at the University of Texas at Arlington, Tarleton State University, or Abilene Christian University. Students majoring in Construction Management are not eligible for award.
- b. The applicant must be an ASCE Student Member in good standing at the time of application and award.
- c. The scholarship may be awarded only to those students who will continue their formal undergraduate and graduate education at one of the recognized educational institutions listed above.
- d. The applicant must demonstrate a commitment to the Civil Engineering industry through the pursuit of a degree in Civil Engineering and participation in ASCE.
- e. Previous recipients of this scholarship are eligible to apply in any succeeding competition for these awards provided the other requirements of eligibility are satisfied.

IV. Application

Complete applications are to be submitted to the Fort Worth Branch for receipt by January 20th of the year of award. Application must include (1) completed application form; (2) 250 to 500-word essay by the applicant that clearly, concisely, and definitely answers the following question: *What attracted you to Civil Engineering and what do you plan on doing with your Civil Engineering career?* (3) official transcripts; and (4) one-page resume. (5) proof of ASCE Student Membership (a printout of screenshot from the ASCE national webpage is sufficient).

V. Selection

- a. Selection of recipients is made by the Fort Worth Branch's Awards Committee.
- b. The committee reserves the right to recommend that no award be made in a particular year if no meritorious applications are received.

- c. Selection is based on appraisal of applicant's essay, resume, academic performance, grade level, education plans, volunteer activities, justification to receive the award, potential for development, and demonstrated leadership qualities.

VI. Awards

- a. The amount of each scholarship will be determined annually and is subject to approval of the Treasurer and the Fort Worth Branch's Awards Committee.
- b. The recipients will be notified of selection in March.
- c. Award funds will be distributed by check and the selected students will be recognized at a monthly meeting of the Fort Worth Branch of ASCE.
- d. Funds may be applied to tuition expenses and academic fees reasonably and logically associated with an undergraduate or graduate engineering program while continuing formal education in an ABET-accredited program.
