The Anan Bay cabin and bear observatory underwent major upgrades to improve safety, accessibility, and visitor experience due to outdated and inadequate existing facilities. PND Engineers led a multi-year improvement project that included cantilevered viewing platforms, a spiral staircase, cedar shelters, and trail enhancements, all designed to minimize environmental impact. The remote location and ecological sensitivity of the site required careful logistical planning, seasonal construction windows, and novel structural solutions like rock anchors and breakaway foundations.




