“South Goldenview Rural Road Service Area Groundwater Challenges”

South Goldenview Rural Road Service Area (SGRRSA) is a Rural Road Service Area in Southeast Anchorage. Over the past 12 years the SGRRSA Road Board has teamed with HDL Engineering Consultants, LLC to make roadway and drainage improvements. One of the major challenges encountered during these improvements has been groundwater. This presentation highlights some specific challenges and efforts to construct functional solutions with limited scope and budget. Three projects will be used to discuss the challenges and lessons learned.
