Scholarship Application

PURPOSE

The Lansing – Jackson Branch of the Michigan Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) encourages the development of students pursuing a civil engineering education. Therefore, the Lansing – Jackson Branch is offering financial support through a scholarship.

AWARD

The Lansing - Jackson Branch of the Michigan Section of ASCE intends to award scholarships to civil engineering students at Michigan State University (MSU). Up to two scholarships will be awarded, each worth \$1,000.00. The scholarships are awarded one-time and are not automatically renewed. The scholarship award is paid directly to the student's account at the MSU Registrar.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must:

- Be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing at Michigan State University in the College of Engineering, Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering. Students working with co-op programs are also eligible.
- Have a cumulative grade-point average of at least 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale or equivalent) at the time of application.
- Submit a current ASCE Scholarship Application (photocopies are accepted) and attach a minimum of one (1) Letter of Recommendation and an official college transcript.

SELECTION PROCESS

Initial judging will be made on the basis of each candidate's academic record, participation in extra-curricular activities, evidence of leadership, character, and self-reliance, and comments from employers and university officials. Preference may be given to applicants that are student members of ASCE and that are active in the student chapter of ASCE.

The scholarship committee reserves the right to use discretion in the award of the available scholarships, and all decisions of the scholarship committee are final.
