Civil engineers have a problem...a huge problem. Many of us, unknowingly, are planning, designing and delivering infrastructure projects that may not meet owner specifications, unable to cope with future environmental operating conditions. Multiple decades of overusing resources and degrading natural systems have altered significantly functions of the Earth's natural systems. Those alterations have changed and continue to change significantly the conditions under which infrastructure projects are supposed to operate. As a result, much of the existing infrastructure, designed for conditions that were historically stable, is now vulnerable to significant damage or failure. Not surprisingly, the generally poor condition of U.S. infrastructure increases that vulnerability and risk.
