Title:

Eklutna River Dam Removal Project



The Conservation Fund launched the effort to remove the Lower Eklutna River Dam in 2015. Built in 1929 as the first major power supply for Anchorage, the 70' tall concrete arch dam was abandoned in 1955 and has since remained an orphan, unmaintained facility. The removal of the Eklutna dam is the most ambitious watershed restoration project ever undertaken in Alaska. In partnership with the Eklutna Native Corporation, the project has advanced faster than any major dam removal previously attempted in the nation.
