Pam will explore the dynamic landscape of traffic engineering in Alaska and across the Nation in this presentation. She will discuss data-driven solutions through the Highway Safety Improvement Program, advances in traveler information and emerging technologies shaping the future of transportation.

Pam has been practicing civil engineering since graduating from Georgia Tech in 1997. When she landed a position in traffic engineering while working for the Idaho Transportation Department in the mid-2000's, she knew instantly she'd found the field she'd want to spend the rest of her career in. She and her husband packed up the family and moved sight-unseen to Fairbanks in 2011 to pursue their dream of living in The Last Frontier. After 11 years as Alaska's Northern Region Traffic and Safety Engineer, she stepped into the role of TSMO/ITS Engineer in Alaska DOT's new Data Modernization and Innovation Office. This January, she became the State Traffic and Safety Engineer, where she manages the Alaska Highway Safety Office, the Traffic and Safety Section, and the TSMO/ITS unit.
