

# YMG STUDENT MEMBER OF THE YEAR

## **Purpose**

The YMG Student Member of the Year Award recognizes an exemplary student member whose initiative, engagement, and enthusiasm have significantly contributed to the mission and activities of the Southeastern Michigan ASCE Younger Member Group. This award honors a student who demonstrates outstanding participation, consistent attendance, and a commitment to supporting ASCE events, programs, and community outreach.

By celebrating students who embody leadership, teamwork, and passion for the civil engineering profession, this award reinforces the vital role that emerging engineers play in advancing the ASCE community and fostering a strong connection between student chapters and the Younger Member Group.

## **Eligibility**

Any registered and *active* student member of ASCE from the following universities: Eastern Michigan University, Lawrence Technological University, University of Detroit Mercy, University of Michigan, and Wayne State University. University student board members *are* eligible, but participation on the student board is not required to be eligible.

## **Award**

The award will consist of a plaque presented at the ASCE Annual Meeting, along with free registration to the meeting.

## **Selection Process**

The selection is made by the Younger Member Group Board with agreement from the Branch Board. The Boards will identify candidates and may also consider suggestions of candidates from ASCE members and students. Only one recipient will be named annually, and annual conferral of the award shall not be obligatory.

***Nominations are not accepted for this award; the committee independently selects the recipient. However, the YMG Board is open to suggestions of who to consider.***
