

YMG SUPPORTING MEMBER AWARD

Purpose

The YMG Supporting Member Award recognizes an outstanding individual whose consistent dedication, mentorship, and active involvement have significantly strengthened the Southeastern Michigan ASCE Younger Member Group and the students we serve. This award honors a member who goes above and beyond in supporting YMG activities, attending events, encouraging student participation, and sharing professional insight that enriches the development of future civil engineers.

Inspired by the unwavering commitment to YMG exemplified by Dr. James Lynch, this award celebrates those who demonstrate exceptional generosity of time, knowledge, and encouragement that has helped cultivate a vibrant, inclusive, and engaged engineering community.

Eligibility

Any individual who demonstrates ongoing involvement in ASCE YMG and ASCE Student activities within the southeastern Michigan area. YMG Board members are not eligible while in term.

Award

The award will consist of a plaque presented at the ASCE Annual Meeting, along with free registration to the meeting.

Selection Process

The selection is made by the Younger Member Group Board with agreement from the Branch Board. The Boards will identify candidates and may also consider suggestions of candidates from ASCE members and students. Only one recipient will be named annually, and annual conferral of the award shall not be obligatory.

Nominations are not accepted for this award; the committee independently selects the recipient. However, the YMG Board is open to suggestions of who to consider.
