#### <u>Abstract</u>

In 2021, the South Carolina Section of ASCE issued our First Report Card for South Carolina's Infrastructure. The report card represents the overall status of eight categories of South Carolina's infrastructure with letter grades based on the system's condition and needs for improvement. This presentation will provide an overview of the findings, a summary of the methodology used to develop the report card, a comparison to the national findings and solutions for the challenges ahead. In addition, we will consider the role of innovation and resilience in the future of infrastructure. We will also discuss how ASCE members can be active in advocating for infrastructure and our profession with emphasis on the use of the report card for those efforts.


