Please join us this month to hear from Rebekah Hammonds and John Davis of TDOT as they speak on I-24 Choice Lanes.

This presentation will focus on the proposed I-24 Southeast Choice Lanes project between Nashville and Murfreesboro. This project is the first of its kind in Tennessee that will include priced managed lanes to proactively manage demand and provide travel-time reliability to those along I-24. This is a Public-Private Partnership (P3) that will aim to help provide options for motorists to bypass congestion and reduce travel times."
