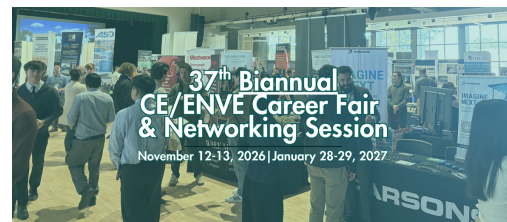


Cal Poly SLO SCE - Open Registration for Biannual Career Fairs & Networking Sessions
